

The Air Control Unit (ACU) developed by WABCO is part of the SCR exhaust after treatment system, which reduces the exhaust emissions. While the engine is running, Urea is injected into the SCR exhaust catalyst. The ACU delivers a preset airflow to the Urea doser.

Offering full functionality in one body, the new Air Control Unit combines three tested WABCO components to provide exhaust gas treatment.

- Integration of pressure limiter valve, solenoid valve and check valve eliminates piping
- Full functionality in one body
