New Trailer EBS E2 – Launch

On 22 November 2010 the first TEBS E Premium modulators of version E2 will leave the production line and start to be fitted on vehicles. The TEBS E Standard modulators will be changed at the beginning of 2011.

The spare parts market will also be supplied with these modulators at this time: older modulators can be replaced 1:1 by modulators with the new software status.

These new functions can be implemented when the old modulator is exchanged. This can increase the value of an older vehicle considerably.

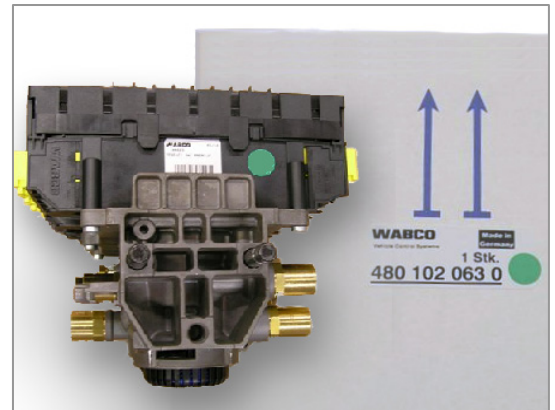

Defining features of the E2 modulators

In appearance the new TEBS E2 modulator is identical to the previous versions.

The new TEBS E2 modulator, however, can easily be identified:

- **Marking:** A green adhesive mark will be attached to the packaging and the modulator for an intervening period.
- **Software version:** As soon as the device is connected to the diagnostics, you can identify the version status E2 by the software version TE002448.
- **Serial number:** You can determine whether it is a TEBS E2 by the serial number on the type label attached to the TEBS E modulator.

New Diagnostic Software & PIN

To set the parameters and commission the TEBS E2 you will need version V2.00 of the TEBS E Diagnostic Software.

Because of the combination with ELEX many new safety-related settings can be made in the system, a new PIN is also required.

Workshops, dealers and haulage companies who already have access to a PIN for older TEBS E modulators because they have completed a Trailer EBS E training course can obtain access to a PIN for the new software by taking part in an E-Learning programme.

This special Upgrade E-Learning programme will only extend the previous PIN to the new Diagnosis. Owners of PIN2 will therefore also obtain PIN2 again through this E-Learning.

From the beginning of 2011 the WABCO training programmes will also be changed to the teaching material for the TEBS E2. Having completed this training programme, "newcomers" will also be able to obtain E-Learning straight away.
