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## Anti-corrosion Protection for Brake Shafts

Minor details can be decisive when mounting slack adjusters onto the brake camshaft. Replacement of the slack adjuster might become impossible later on if you did not apply life-time lubrication on the tooth profile (e.g. nickel paste).

Penetration of humidity into the unprotected splines will cause crevice corrosion. When the slack adjuster was exposed for a long period to it then you cannot remove it any longer even when using a pull-off tool.

So be fair to the mechanic who has to break up the connections years later. Provide sufficient anti-corrosion protection.

It might become your own pain in the neck otherwise.
